General risks and precautions to prevent the risks:

Before use

Read and follow the instructions on the packaging or added to the packaging.

If you have any questions about the use, contact the manufacturer.

Keep the products out of reach of children.

1. Risk of skin, eye and respiratory irritation

Avoid direct contact with the skin – wear protective gloves when you use the product.

Do not let the product come into contact with your eyes – if that happens, immediately rinse your eyes with a lot of water and consult a doctor if irritation persists.

Do not inhale the fumes – use the product in well-ventilated rooms.

2. Risk of allergic reactions

Before use, check the product's list of ingredients to make sure that it does not contain substances to which you are allergic.

If you have allergic symptoms such as rash, skin redness, coughing or difficulty breathing, stop using the product and consult a doctor.

3. Risk of poisoning

Do not consume the cleaning products and do not store them in packaging that resembles food or beverage packaging.

Keep the cleaning products out of reach of children and pets to prevent accidental swallowing.

If the cleaning product is swallowed, immediately contact a poison centre or doctor and give them the product information on the packaging.

4. Risk of chemical damage to the surface

Use the product as recommended by the manufacturer – do not mix the cleaning products.

5. Storage risks

Store the cleaning products in their original packaging with the lids firmly closed to prevent accidental spillage.

Do not store the products near heat sources, open flame or direct sunlight.

Avoid storing the products in a humid environment that could affect their durability and properties.

6. Risk of improper use

Use the cleaning products only for their intended purpose – do not use the products on surfaces or materials for which they are not recommended.

7. Risk of leakage and damage to the packaging

Regularly check the packaging for leaks or damage – if necessary, pour or put the product into a suitable leakproof and correctly labelled container.

Do not store the cleaning products near food or kitchen utensils.

8. Environmental risks

Avoid pouring residues of the product down the drain if this is not permitted – follow the disposal instructions on the packaging.

9. Utility risk

Regarding the liquid descaler – 250 ml: When you use too much of the descaler, use it too often or incorrectly (for example when you do not dilute it or the proportions are wrong), it can damage your appliance or lead to its malfunction. Rinse the appliance several times after use.

Inadequate rinsing: If you do not thoroughly rinse the appliance after you used the descaler, residues of the product can remain in the appliance and end up in food or beverages, which is a health hazard.

When you follow the above warnings, you minimise the risk of danger. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe and take the above precautions.
