General risks and precautions to prevent the risks:

Before use

Read and follow the instructions on the packaging or added to the packaging.

If you have any questions about the use, contact the manufacturer.

Keep moisture absorbers out of reach of children.

1. Risk of skin, eye and respiratory irritation

Avoid direct contact with the skin – wear protective gloves when you install or replace the product.

Do not let the product come into contact with your eyes – if that happens, immediately rinse your eyes with a lot of water and consult a doctor if irritation persists.

2. Risk of allergic reactions

Before use, check the product's list of ingredients to make sure that it does not contain substances to which you are allergic.

If you have allergic symptoms such as rash, skin redness, coughing or difficulty breathing, stop using the product and consult a doctor.

3. Risk of poisoning

Do not consume the product and do not store it in packaging that resembles food or beverage packaging.

Keep the product out of reach of children and pets to prevent accidental swallowing.

If the product is swallowed, immediately contact a poison centre or doctor and give them the product information on the label.

4. Risk of chemical damage to the surface

Make sure that the condensed liquid does not spill to the surface, for example of furniture. It can leave a white stain, which you can remove using a wet cloth and detergent.

Use the product as recommended by the manufacturer.

5. Storage risks

Do not store the product near heat sources, open flame or direct sunlight.

Avoid storing closed products in a humid environment that could affect their durability and properties.
